

Environmental Policy

The ISO14001 Environmental management system of S & B Eps Ltd shall be aimed at minimizing the effects of its production and distribution operations on the environment. This will include:

These measures will be applied to all materials and resources as deemed appropriate, with effective control of their use and subsequent disposal. S & B Eps Ltd will seek to identify its effects on pollution and the environment, and take steps to reduce these where practicable in a responsible manner.

Every employee shall be encouraged to actively contribute towards improving the environmental performance of the company, through release of information, effective training and supervision; S & B Eps Ltd shall promote sound environmental awareness and a sense of responsibility in its employees.

S & B Eps Ltd will adhere to all applicable legal and other regulatory requirements, and have processes in place to deal with any emergency situation or accident.

S & B Eps Ltd suppliers and service providers will be encouraged to be environmentally responsible, and the environmental credentials of a new supplier will be considered when awarding business.

On the basis of the above, S & B Eps Ltd shall:

- Recycle all EPS waste created internally
- Utilise the best available distribution options
- Where possible recycle any other waste produced, such as cardboard
- Assist any customers requiring information on environmental issues

The Environmental Management System of S & B Eps Ltd will be continuously evaluated and improved through the setting of environmental objectives and targets. These will be set by audits and management reviews.
